## Methods to participate:

- 1. Each student will receive a Reading Record Book for both Chinese and English.
- 2. Students may borrow books from the public library or purchase suitable books for themselves to read.
- 3. After students complete reading the assigned books or self-selected books (P. 1: Picture Books; P. 2: Fables; P. 3: Eastern or Western Fairy Tales; P. 4: Journey to the West or other famous novels; P. 5: Romance of the Three Kingdoms or other famous novels; P. 6: Water Margin), students have to finish a simple book report and record the information of each book, including the title and the date of book completion. Parents are required to sign on the Reading Record Book to confirm their child has completed the reading.
- 4. After reading 5 books, students may get a stamp from the teacher-librarian Ms. Lee.
- 5. At the end of the scheme, the school will give out Gold Award, Silver Award and Bronze Award according to the reading record of students.
